Firearms; Possession Within Casino or Casino Simulcasting Facility (a) No person, including the security department members, shall possess or be permitted to possess any pistol or firearm within a casino or casino simulcasting facility without the express written approval of the Commission provided that employees and agents of the Division may possess such pistols or firearms at the discretion of the director of the Division. (b) To obtain approval for the possession of a pistol or firearm within a casino or casino simulcasting facility, a person shall be required to demonstrate that: 1. He has received an adequate course of training in the possession and use of such pistol or firearm; 2. He is the holder of a valid license for the possession of such pistol or firearm; and 3. There is a compelling need for the possession of such pistol or firearm within the casino or casino simulcasting facility. 3. (c) Each casino licensee shall cause to be posted in a conspicuous location at each entrance to the casino and casino simulcasting facility a sign that may be easily read stating: "By law, no person shall possess any pistol or firearm within the casino or casino simulcasting facility without the express written permission of the Casino Control Commission."
