## Are Gangs Taking Advantage Of Carry Laws?

Gangs across the U.S.A. have used 'clean' people for some time, to purchase firearms from FFL dealers. These individuals have no felony charges. When run through a background check, no felony background or a history of violence appears. Because of this, they are cleared to purchase firearms including handguns. This is called a 'straw' purchase. It is a crime.



Law Enforcement Officers are stopping more vehicles where the driver has a Carry License or Permit, but the other people in the vehicle could not get one because of their felony history. Just like buying handguns with a 'straw' purchase, the driver is now able to transport handguns from state to state because of being legally armed. How could this be stopped?

In almost every state that has enacted some type of carry law, the Sheriff is a part of the investigation process. Other investigative avenues like the F.B.I., and

Some states require mandatory training before a Carry License or Permit is issued. Those states that make training mandatory, give some necessary information to their state residents. One area that affects every Legally Armed Citizen is how to handle a traffic stop when you are armed.

LegallyArmed.com felt it would be a benefit to those individuals who are not required to take training, to hear and see from a Police Officer what both parties, the citizen and the officer, should do in a traffic stop where the driver is a Legally Armed Citizen.

We understand that some who read this article will think it is not a good idea to inform the Police Officer that they are armed. We are not trying to change the thinking of anyone. We only want to give information that some people may never see. However, keep in mind that some states require that a Legally Armed Citizen advise the Police Officer if they are armed. ## Draw & Fire

One of the most important elements of carrying a handgun, is to be able to draw & accurately fire the pistol within 1 to 1 1/2 seconds. Seems fairly easy to do, right? Well, consider that at 10 P.M. you are walking to your door when some creep jumps out in front of you, and demands money. He is carrying a knife to make you agree to give him your money. What do you do?

If you just carry a pistol in your purse or on your belt, and have not practiced drawing the pistol and have not practiced with your gun, give the thug your groceries, money, and whatever else you think he might take, that will make him leave you alone. But, most thugs when they get something, want more.

Without preparing yourself for this encounter, the odds are against you. You could hurt yourself, a neighbor, or someone in your own home by a misplaced shot. Also, if the thug gets your gun, you have more problems to think about.

the state regulatory agency are involved but, the Sheriff is the Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the County. The Sheriff is the most reliable source to deny the Carry License or Permit because of “moral turpitude”. However, most Sheriff’s are not doing enough of a background check. With more and more gang associates receiving Carry Licenses and Permits, it is all the good people who have received their authorization to carry, that will be affected when these people do something that is criminal. We all know this can happen.

Could this also be used by a Sheriff to deny a Carry License or Permit to an individual who is not in the same political

party as the Sheriff, or for some other reason. Because we are speaking about “Moral Turpitude”, the Sheriff would have to have something that lead to this decision. Relationships with known gang members could be a reason. If a Sheriff in a ‘shall’ issues state, were to deny an application to a person, there has to be some reason given for the denial. It can’t be because of opposing the Sheriff in an election, or something like that. However, if an applicant has close ties to know gang members, this is within the scope of denying a license or permit.

Some will not agree with the content of this article, but if not addressed, we will all feel problems this might create. End

## Draw & Fire Cont.

If you don't have the time or extra funds for training, you can prepare yourself in your own home.

In front of a full or half-size mirror, practice drawing from your carry rig with your **'Un-Loaded'** carry gun. Use some type of timing device to let you know how long each draw took to complete, and to be on your silhouette in the mirror. Don't work for speed. Work for a smooth draw and an effortless presentation of the pistol on your silhouette. What you are doing is training your mind and body to work instinctively when required by circumstances to defend yourself.


When you are able to get to a range to practice, go over what you have taught yourself at home, and shoot your target with live ammo. This will embed in you the reaction of your carry gun when fired, and increase your odds if you have to draw & fire your carry gun in a self-defense incident.

## I.D. Pouch

Since we introduced the Legally Armed I.D. Pouch™, there has been a lot of controversy about the product. Some are saying that it is just a gimmick to make some extra money.
